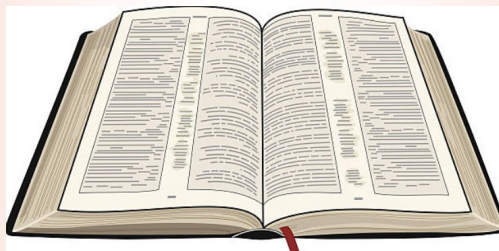

Eulogy - Read by Danny Shaw (Brother)

Ehud Morgan—affectionately known as Everall—was a man whose life was marked by intelligence, humour, resilience, and unwavering faith. Born on 12 January 1974, he was the youngest of twelve children in the loving Morgan family. As the “baby” of the household, he shared deep bonds with his siblings and carried the memory of those who passed before him with great tenderness.

From an early age, Everall showed remarkable curiosity and a sharp mind. Family stories recall him skipping the walking stage entirely and running sprinting, full of energy and determination. Even as a toddler, he engaged adults in conversations far beyond his years, his quick wit and lively spirit already shining through.

His school years at Wittington Oval Primary and Byng Kendrick Central Comprehensive revealed two lifelong passions: learning and boxing. With natural athleticism and fierce competitive drive, he excelled in amateur boxing, earning admiration for both his skill and his powerful physique. His playful humour was ever-present, especially in stories of opponents intimidated before the first punch was thrown. He approached every challenge—physical or intellectual—with the mindset of a champion.

Music was another defining part of his life. A gifted drummer, he played joyfully in church, using his talent to serve God. He loved vinyl records and took pride in sharing new music with brother, always seeking the perfect sound. Stylish and confident, he carried himself with a distinctive elegance.

Academically, Everall excelled. He earned a BTEC National Diploma with distinctions from Sutton College and graduated with Honours from the University of Westminster. His dedication led to a distinguished career in IT, where he rose to become a National SAP Security Consultant, later a Director, and eventually the founder of his own company. He was respected nationally and internationally for his professionalism, intelligence, and integrity. Even when facing racial bias, he responded with dignity, honesty, and unshakeable self-belief.

Faith and family were central to his life. His marriage to Laxmi on 13 July 2002 was a meaningful chapter, and his close relationship with his mother-in-law Ishwari brought him great warmth—especially her cooking. Even after separation, he and Laxmi remained respectful and supportive friends.

In his later years, as he faced serious health challenges, Everall’s resilience became his greatest testimony. He encouraged others, uplifted them, and continued to live with purpose and faith.

Ehud—our Everall—will be remembered for his strength, kindness, humour, and the love he shared so freely. His legacy lives on in the many lives he touched.
